Introduction

The monthly publication of Building Materials Price Statistics is of great significance as building material prices are deemed to be important economic indicators for planning and research in various fields. They are also used in the compilation of indices of the construction activity and for the calculation of GDP at constant prices.

Statistical centres all over the world collect prices of building materials used by a large segment of people. As a result of the urban development and the constant growth in the construction sector in the Emirate, Statistics Centre – Abu Dhabi collects price data for these materials on a regular basis.

The movements of prices of 21 groups from the key building materials are included in this publication (table 5). This information helps decision and policy makers and researchers in planning and making sound decisions in support of the building materials sector and other sectors associated with it.

Key Points

This publication provides an analysis of the movement of the average prices of building materials during the month of October 2015 compared with September 2015 and October 2014. The key changes were:

- During October 2015 the average prices of the 'Pipes (PVC)', 'Wires for small building' and 'Diesel' groups increased by 4.1%, 3.3% and 1.6% respectively, compared with September 2015.
- During October 2015 the price of 'Pipes (uPVC)' decreased by 10.1%, 'Steel' by 4.7% and 'Waterproofing products' by 1.8% compared with September 2015.
- During October 2015 the average price of the 'Employment' group increased by 18.2%, 'False ceiling' by 11.1% and 'Tiles and marble' by 8.5% compared with October 2014.
- During October 2015, the average prices of 'Steel', 'Waterproofing products' and 'Diesel' decreased by 24.6%, 19.7% and 19.6% respectively, compared with the same period in the previous year.

Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for October 2015 compared with September 2015

The increases in the average prices in October 2015 compared with September 2015, ranged between 0.2% for the 'Power cable' group and 4.1% for the 'Pipes (PVC)' group. Decreases ranging from 0.9% for 'Tiles and marble' and 10.1% for the 'Pipes (uPVC)' group were recorded.

Pipes (PVC)

The average prices of 'Pipes (PVC)' increased by 4.1% in October 2015 compared with September 2015, as a result of an increase in most items in this group.

Diesel

The price of 'Diesel' increased by 1.6% in October 2015 compared with September 2015.

Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' increased by 1.5% in October 2015 compared with September 2015. Table (2) shows changes in wages of 'Employment' during October 2015.

Paints

The average prices of 'Paints' increased by 1.4% in October 2015 compared with September 2015, as a result of an increase in some items in this group.

Pipes (uPVC)

The average prices of 'Pipes (uPVC)' decreased by 10.1% in October 2015 compared with September 2015, as a result of a decrease in all items in this group.

Steel

The average prices of 'Steel' decreased by 4.7% in October 2015 compared with September 2015.

Waterproofing products

The average prices of 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 1.8% in October 2015 compared with September 2015, as a result of a decrease in some items in this group.


Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for October 2015 compared with October 2014

The monthly average prices for 15 groups of building materials have decreased in October 2015 compared with October 2014. The decreases ranged between 0.4% for 'Transport equipment' and 24.6% for 'Steel'.

Steel

The average prices of the 'Steel' group decreased by 24.6% in October 2015 compared with October 2014

Waterproofing products

The average prices of 'Waterproofing products' decreased by 19.7% in October 2015 compared with October 2014, as a result of decreases in most items in this group.

Diesel

The price of 'Diesel' decreased by 19.6% in October 2015 compared with October 2014.

Power cable

The average prices of 'Power cable' decreased by 12.7% in October 2015 compared with October 2014, as a result of a decrease in all items in this group.



Some building materials items have seen an increase in October 2015 compared with October 2014:

Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' increased by 18.2% in October 2015 compared with October 2014, as a result of increases in most items in this group.

False ceiling

The average prices of 'False ceiling' increased by 11.1% in October 2015 compared with October 2014, with most items in the group recording an increase.

Tiles and marble

The 'Tiles and marble' group increased by 8.5% in October 2015 compared with October 2014.
