### Introduction

The monthly publication of Building Materials Price Statistics is of great significance as building material prices are deemed to be important economic indicators for planning and research in various fields. They are also used in the compilation of indices of the construction activity and for the calculation of GDP at constant prices.

Statistical centres all over the world collect prices of building materials used by a large segment of people. As a result of the urban development and the constant growth in the construction sector in the Emirate, Statistics Centre – Abu Dhabi collects price data for these materials on a regular basis.

The movements of prices of 21 groups from the key building materials are included in this publication (table 5). This information helps decision and policy makers and researchers in planning and making sound decisions in support of the building materials sector and other sectors associated with it.

### **Key Points**

This publication provides an analysis of the movement of the average prices of building materials during the month of January 2015 compared with December 2014 and January 2014. The key changes were:

- During January 2015 the average prices of the 'Natural stone', 'Pipes (PVC)', 'Pipes (uPVC)' and 'Wood' groups increased by 4.0%, 3.0%, 1.2% and 0.9% respectively, compared with December 2014.

- During January 2015 the average prices of the 'Employment' group decreased by 8.9%, 'Power cable' by 5.2% and 'Concrete' by 2.2%, compared with December 2014.

- During January 2015 the average prices of both 'Concrete' and 'Block' increased by 4.6%, 'Natural stone' by 4.0%, 'Wires for apartment' by 2.9%, and 'Aggregates and sand' by 2.8%, compared with January 2014.

— During January 2015, the average prices of 'Power cable', 'Wires for residential towers' and 'Paints' decreased by 11.8%, 9.6% and 8.5% respectively, compared with the same period in the previous year.

## 1. Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for January 2015 compared with December 2014

The building materials groups have seen a change in the average prices in January 2015 compared with December 2014, with increases ranging between 0.2% for the 'Tiles and marble' group and 4.0% for the 'Natural stone' group. Decreases ranging from 0.1% for the 'Cement' group to 8.9% for the 'Employment' group were recorded.

### **Employment**

The average wages of 'Employment' decreased by 8.9% in January 2015 compared with December 2014. Table (1) shows decreases ranged between 5.6% and 28.0%.

### **Power cable**

The average prices of 'Power cable' decreased by 5.2% in January 2015 compared with December 2014, as a result of decreases in all items in this group.

### Natural stone

The 'Natural stone' group increased by 4.0% in January 2015, as a result of an increase in some items in this group compared with December 2014.

### Pipes (PVC)

The average prices of 'Pipes (PVC)' decreased by 3.0% in January 2015 compared with December 2014.

### Concrete

The average prices of 'Concrete' decreased by 2.2% in January 2015 compared with December 2014.

# 2. Key changes in the monthly average prices of building materials for January 2015 compared with January 2014

The monthly average prices for 11 groups of building materials have decreased in January 2015 compared with January 2014. The fall ranged between 0.8% for 'Waterproofing products' and 11.8% for 'Power cable'.

### **Power cable**

The average prices of 'Power cable' decreased by 11.8% in January 2015 compared with January 2014.


### Wires

The average prices of 'Wires' decreased in January 2015 compared with January 2014. 'Wires for residential towers' accounted for the largest decrease of 9.6%, followed by 'Small buildings' with 5.0%, while 'Wires for apartment' increased by 2.9%.

### Employment

The average wages of 'Employment' decreased by 8.9% in January 2015 compared with January 2014, as a result of decreases in all items in this group between 4.3% and 12.5%.

### Steel

The average prices of 'Steel' decreased by 5.0% in January 2015, as a result of decreases in most items in this group compared with January 2014.

#### **Paints**

The average prices of 'Paints' decreased by 8.5% in January 2015 compared with January 2014.

Some building materials items have seen an increase in January 2015 compared with January 2014.

### **Block**

The 'Block' group increased by 4.6% in January 2015 compared with January 2014.

### Concrete

The average prices of 'Concrete' increased by 4.6% in January 2015 compared with January 2014, as a result of increases in all items in this group.

#### **Natural stone**

The average prices of 'Natural stone' increased by 4.0% in January 2015 compared with January 2014, with some items in the group recording an increase.
